
FORBIDDEN SEX – Part One

This message is for everyone, young and old single or married. We all influence others in our lives. Many of us are raising children that will need to understand this, or we have friends and family too that need to know what God says about this subject. So don't tune out just because you're married and I am beginning with fornication. Make no mistake about it, continuing in the sin of fornication will keep you out of heaven.



The short answer is no!

People kid themselves saying, oh we will abstain from sex. We won't tempt each other. When you are newly dating you are kidding yourself telling yourself you won't be tempted. That's all that will be on your mind. How the other person smells, wanting to be next to them, wanting to touch them, watching them walk across the room, etc. Before you know it you are living in fornication. What's that? It is a big word. I sure never understood what it meant when I was a teenager.

FORNICATION – sexual intercourse between two people not married to each other. Living together and having sex. Having sex when you are not married. Having sex before you get married. Yes, all of this is fornication and it is sin. I know a lady who is in her 70's and divorced. She used to talk about having to abstain from sex. This was when I was still a baby Christian and I used to think, well you don't have to abstain, you have already been married. She would say that in the same way a homosexual person has to come before God and ask forgiveness and repent and stop their sexual relations, that she had to do the same thing and abstain. At that time I wasn't getting it. But I grew in the Lord and came to understand that what she was saying was right. If you are not married then sex is off limits according to God.

Love - a feeling of strong or constant affection for a person. : attraction that includes sexual desire : the strong affection felt by people who have a romantic relationship.


Lust - very strong sexual desire.



If you are dating someone and they do this to you – drop that person! They are not respecting you. And this is a great indication of what type of person they are – not faithful.

Oh, I am not Polyanna, I had sex before I was married. I was not taught Biblically what God has to say about this. I did not realize what a sin it is to Him even though I knew it was considered wrong. I wasn't living for the Lord then. My mom had only said, you need to wait until you are married. However, I knew she didn't

wait because of the timing of when she had my first brother compared to her anniversary date. So I figured, why was she telling me to do something that she didn't do. So when is this ok according to God?

Did you know that God is very big on covenants? A covenant is a mutual agreement. He keeps His Word.

Numbers 23:19a - God is not a man, that He should lie;

Did you know marriage is a covenant between a man and a woman? It is a blood covenant when the woman has kept herself pure (a virgin). A virgin woman has something called a hymen and when this is broken during consummation blood is shed. God considers a man and wife one flesh when they are married. And don't think because the woman is the one that sheds blood that it doesn't matter if the

guy is a virgin or not. In God's standard, the man should also wait until marriage to have sex.

Mark 10:6-9 - But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; And the two shall be one flesh: so then they are no more two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man put asunder.

The only time sex is acceptable according to God and His Word is when a man and a woman are married. I praise God that I did not die in my sin of fornication because I would have gone to hell.

Want to know what happens when you sleep around and don't wait until marriage?




I Cor.:6:16-18 - Don't you know that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, says He (God), shall be one flesh. But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. "Flee fornication. Every sin that a man does is without (outside) the body; but he that commits fornication sins against his own body.

You are joined to the flesh of that person even if they are not a harlot. This is also where something called "soul ties" can come into your life. Demons and things that haunt that person's life can be transferred during sexual intercourse and so

then come into your life and harass you. This is a very serious thing in the eyes of the Lord and should be so in our eyes too. Sin has consequences. God will forgive all sin except blaspheming the Holy Spirit. But even though your sin is forgiven doesn't mean there won't be consequences.

STD'S - Sexually transmitted diseases are caused by infections that are passed from one person to another during sexual contact. Many std's are not curable. Many times there aren't even signs or traces that a person has an std and they may not even know it. So you can't just look at someone and think they don't have anything and it's ok because you won't catch anything or take their word for it.



Syphilis on the back.


There are people that are sick and infected and mad about it and they just want to infect others, as many as they can.

Deut.28:27 - The LORD will smite thee with the botch of Egypt, and with the emerods (tumors), and with the scab, and with the itch, whereof thou canst not be healed.

This is part of the curses that God pronounced against Israel if they did not follow Him. These same curses apply to those that don't take Jesus as their Savior and love and obey Him. If you haven't laid your life down and made Jesus Lord of your life, then you are not under the new covenant. It means the curses of the old covenant apply to you.

And just to be clear, when He is Lord of your life it means you ask Him what your purpose is, it means you go to Him before you make decisions in your life, it means you honor Him with your life, your time, your money and all that you have. You worship and praise Him. You read His Word because you want to know all that He said and you understand that He still speaks through His Word. You pray to Him and let Him know your hearts desires, you pray for others, you bring your needs before Him even though He already knows everything. You have an intimate relationship with Him. You long to be with Him. He is your standard. You continually ask Him to teach you and grow you in His Spirit. You ask Him to mold and shape you and to help you to stop and get rid of anything that doesn't please Him. You ask Him to use you for His glory and honor and Kingdom. You take Him seriously. You don't just act like you love Him on Sundays after you've been out to the bar all night long drinking and trying to pick somebody up. You don't just love Him when you get in trouble and need to call on Him.

Phil.2:12 - Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.



Genesis 39:12 - And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

Genesis 39:21 - But the LORD was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison. **God will honor you when you put Him first.**

Acts 7:9-10 - And the patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him, And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house.




No shame, not even thinking about God.

Matt.15:16-20 - Read out

CLOSING

1 Cor. 6:19-20 - What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: *It is* good for a man not to touch a woman.
