FORBIDDEN SEX – Part Two

Before we get into talking about adultery today, I have a few things that I want to cover that I didn't go over in the first part on Fornication.

KISSING



Is kissing ok?

What is appropriate or when is a line crossed? Kissing is something that can certainly lead to other things happening. When you are both attracted to each other and you have had a good date or time together and he/she smells good and they are saying all the right things and you are curious about each other and a little touch here and a little kiss on the ear lobe and a little caress there, pushing the limit with roaming hands and the next thing you know hormones are raging and it is all systems go!!! Then you are in the flesh and you are going to want to

throw caution to the wind and go for it. STOP! I certainly have been there with the getting too close too soon. Maybe it's the end of the night and you are just going to have a good night kiss but it is a major kiss and you are all hugged up on each other and there is the chemistry and the body heat. When you are truly living holy, you don't want to put yourself or the other person in this situation. A non lingering simple kiss should be good enough. If you do more than that you are flirting with letting your guard down and committing lust or fornication which both are a sin.



Last week we came to the knowledge that only in marriage does God place His blessing for sex which is out of love for each other.

CONTRACEPTIVES

I spoke with Pastor Erustus on this issue and we are in agreement on this. Contraceptives can be used for birth control for those in marriages only but not outside of marriage which is fornication and adultery. Many are involved in illicit sex and so they use contraceptives to avoid getting pregnant, being infected by

diseases and so they use condoms or other methods of protection. Others don't want to give birth to children because they don't want to lose their shape. Some avoid having children to give a marriage a trial i.e if it works well, then maybe they will go forward and have children. But if it doesn't, we part ways. All this has led to an increase in immorality. So the question is why is one using the contraceptives?

Adultery – voluntary sexual intercourse between a married person and a person who is not his or her spouse.



King David and Bathsheba, probably the most famous case of adultery.

King David repented after Nathan the Prophet pointed out his sin. But sin has consequences.

2 Sam.12:9-16 – Read this out

Psalm 38:7 - For my loins are filled with a loathsome *disease*: and *there is* no soundness in my flesh.

Remember King David had a lot of wives and concubines. And God never approved of this even though He allowed it. Let's take a lesson from King David and avoid this consequence in our lives.



Syphilis on the hand. (Syphilis can be cured, however – genital herpes, genital warts, HIV and hepatitis B cannot be cured)



Remember that guy you dated that boldly checked out other women right in front of you. So you married him anyway...

Matt. 5:28 – Jesus said - But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Physical adultery and spiritual adultery are both sin. When you actually sleep with someone you are not married too outside of your marriage that is adultery. When you lust after someone according to Jesus in the new testament, that is adultery of the heart.

For those of you who work, you must guard your relationships. It is not proper to have a friend of the opposite sex that you go to lunch with every day or that you tell all of your secrets to. If you get good news, who is the first person you call? Is it your best friend at work? Or is it your spouse? If it isn't your spouse, you have a problem already in your marriage.



Adultery causes heart ache.



What else does adultery cause? Arguing, jealousy, unforgiveness, divorce etc.

Proverbs Chapter 5 – Read out

Masturbation – erotic stimulation especially of one's own genital organs commonly resulting in orgasm and achieved by manual or other bodily contact exclusive of sexual intercourse, by instrumental manipulation, occasionally by sexual fantasies, or by various combinations of these agencies.

Some may think this is fine because it isn't involving anyone else. This is sinning against your own body and opens a door for satan to come in. He will send in spirits of lust, unclean spirits, spirits of addiction, perverse spirits and spirits of masterbation and you begin to be tormented. You begin to be in bondage and think about this more and more and wanting to bring pleasure to yourself until it has control of you and you are no longer in control. This can drive a wedge between you and your husband/wife to where they are not pleasing you any longer or you don't desire to be intimate with them because you have already pleased yourself.

ANAL SEX

Sharing more from Pastor Erustus: To me I think this kind of sex is also unnatural and unspiritual and if am not wrong unlawful too. Unfortunately he is wrong about that because we have now begun to legalize homosexuality in the U.S. **Sodomy laws in the United States**, which outlawed a variety of sexual acts, were historically universal. While they often targeted sexual acts between persons of the same sex, many statutes employed definitions broad enough to outlaw certain sexual acts between persons of different sexes as well, sometimes even acts between married persons.

Through the 20th century, the gradual liberalization of American sexual morals led to the elimination of sodomy laws in most states. During this time, the Supreme Court upheld the constitutionality of sodomy lawsin *Bowers v. Hardwick* in 1986. However, in 2003 the Supreme Court reversed the decision with *Lawrence v. Texas*, invalidating sodomy laws in the remaining 14 states (Alabama, Florida, Idaho, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri (state wide), North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, and Virginia).

Sodomy has caused a high spread of AIDS too.

Oral sex - sexual activity in which the genitals of one partner are stimulated by the mouth of the other;

You may think this is fine as it is not penetration. That is what Bill Clinton believes. I assure you this is fornication when done outside of marriage. In the context of marriage this is something that is considered unnatural. God did not make our sexual appendages for this type of interaction.



It is unnatural for a man or woman to desire or prefer an ejaculation to be done in the mouth. God designed for a man to ejaculate in a woman's birth canal or vagina. Having sex and making love are two different things here. Many people in having sex, get carried into all kinds of perversions. I believe is spiritually unlawful for one to have a desire, preference or attitude for oral sex. One can have foreplay in which one can kiss or caress his/her mate's private parts. But it's unnatural sex where a woman or a man develops an attitude of ejaculating in the mouth . So oral sex is moving from natural sex to unnatural sex.

I Cor.: 6:9-10 - Don't you know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the Kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither FORNICATORS, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor *effeminate (perverts & homosexuals /womanish & womanly used as in reproach), nor *abusers of themselves with mankind, (Young's literal translation has the word sodomites here) nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the Kingdom of God.

*effeminate – G3120 – malakos - Definition: (a) soft, (b) of persons: soft, delicate, effeminate. a male who submits his body to unnatural lewdness. metaphorically, and in a bad sense: effeminate, of a catamite -


cat·a·mite – noun, archaic, a boy kept for homosexual practices. Paul and the Apostles back in the Biblical times dealt with temple prostitutes as many people were in idolatry and practiced sexual immorality in worshiping their gods (demons/satan).

*Abusers of themselves with mankind - Definition: a male engaging in samegender sexual activity; a sodomite, *pederast.

733 arsenokoítēs (from <u>730</u> /árrhēn, "a male" and <u>2845</u> /koítē, "a mat, bed") – properly, a man in bed with another man; a homosexual.

* Define **pederast**: a man who desires or engages in sexual activity with a boy.


Homosexuality – is romantic attraction, sexual attraction or sexual behavior between members of the same sex or gender.

Whoremonger – G4205 – pornos - **Definition:** a fornicator, man who prostitutes himself. **4205** *pórnos* (from *pernaō*, "to sell off") – properly, a male prostitute. <u>4205</u> (*pórnos*) is "*properly*, 'a male prostitute' (so Xen., etc.); *in the NT*, any *fornicator*" (*Abbott-Smith*); i.e. anyone engaging in sexual immorality. <u>See</u> <u>4202</u> (*porneia*). fornicators (2), immoral (2), immoral men (1), immoral people (2), immoral person (1), immoral persons (2). **a man who prostitutes his body to**

another's lust for hire, a male

prostitute,((Aristophanes), Xenophon, Demosthenes, Aeschines, Lucian); universally, a man who indulges in unlawful sexual intercourse, a fornicator fornicator, whoremonger.

Do you think adulterers are loving and making a lie? Yes.

Pastor Erustus speaking: Pastor in all we do including sex we must have a good conscience towards God. Many do unnatural and unlawful sex despite their conscience condemning them, remember all will give an account before God. Many men and women have ungodly preferences, appetites and attitudes for sex. People must go back to the natural act of sex.
