#### OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM – CHILDREN'S HOSTEL

The hostel started about 7 years ago with about 10 residential students, and at one point there were a total of 20 residential students. Since its inception, 10 students have graduated. Currently, there are 10 residential students aged from 6 to 15 years, 5 of whom come from very poor families, and 8 of whom come from families without a father.

They attend three schools in the area (a government primary school, a private primary school and a government secondary school). They live up to 1 hour's drive away, in other villages, and they go home around 4 times a year to attend festivals, weddings or other events.

There are many other children whose families would like them to be resident at the hostel. The hostel is run by two 'house-mothers' who take care of the children, do all of the washing and cleaning, and so on. One is in her mid 20s and the other is in her early 30s, and neither has had more than 8th Standard education; both are widows whose children are also residents of the hostel. The hostel is their home and they have no other home; they go to visit their families for only 2 or 3 days in a year. They have both been with the hostel since its inception.

The after-school programme takes place in the same building as the hostel, and also involves the children who live at the hostel. Approximately 20 children come regularly, in the same age range as the resident children, all of whom live within about 30 minutes' walk of the facility. The programme runs for approximately an hour each weekday, and the children learn songs and stories from the Bible.

It is staffed by the two housemothers of the hostel, plus another married woman from the village, in her mid 20s, who started working there only two months ago, and brings her daughter to participate in the programmes; she has completed her education to the 12th Standard, hence she is probably the most educated woman in the entire village. Previously there was another volunteer who left to get married; there have only ever been four volunteers who run the programme. As with the hostel house-mothers, this other volunteer is also paid an honorarium for her work.

## **TAILORING PROGRAM**

This programme has been in existence for about 5-7 years in each of the villages. Since its inception, it has been led by some volunteer trainers from the village who are experienced in tailoring. Many girls, young women and older women

have participated in the tailoring programme in each village. Many have left the programme when they left the village to get married. The classes are generally held twice a week, for about 2 hours each, though often the participants stay longer to finish their projects. The women learn how to sew by hand and by machine; each group has one sewing machine. They make clothes for themselves (the clothes are generally not for sale) with fabric that they buy, and they also recycle old clothes to make clothes for their children. The groups meet in private homes in the villages, which are rented by MUS. The other MUS programmes all meet in the same locations.

## THREE HEARTS SCHOOL

Three heart school is growing good by the grace of God now we have 57 children in the school and through this school we are able to share gospel among the families of the village through these children and these children are doing good in their studies and the children are regularly growing in the word of God, as well as their studies. Three heart schooling is thank full to Sister Cherie Brother Scott, Kennedy & Three heart Church congregation because of them we are able to run the school because of their prayer and God grace, by the help of the school we are able to share gospel not only



to the children but we are also able to have the gathering with the parents and the grand parents also by which they are also able to hear the gospel of the God and we are so happy to do it because by the grace of God the gospel is being heard by many others also and this is an achievements for Three Heart ministry India that we are the first Christian school in the area and by which God is getting glory we are not sharing the education but we are building the pillars for his kingdom by this School and without the help and prayers of Sister Cherie Brother Scott, Kennedy & Three heart Church congregation it won't be possible for us to do this work so widely in this Himalayan poor community and all glory goes to Him it is all his grace.

## YESHU SAT SANGATI (JESUS FELLOWSHIP GROUP)

The churches are being running in the different area of Himalayan rural poor community, we have given the name of House Church (Yeshu Sat Sangati) means Jesus Fellowship Group, through which we are sharing gospel all over the villages, and all this is because of sister Cherie brother Scott, Kennedy & Three Heart Congregation prayer's for us, that here we are able to share the gospel in these areas where people does not know about salvation today they are able to know, I really thank God for it.

This time we had a gathering of 35-38 women's and children of the hostel where we shared gospel among the women's, it was great sharing with the women's here in the village they have all the burden with on themselves to see their children, house work, field and see their cattles to but by this we just made them a kind of outing or picnic for them where we prepared the lunch with them and ate with them only and the sang some songs dance and enjoyed with the hostel children and we also had distributed some price for the women's just to motivate them and it was just to encourage their work that what they are doing for the ministry.
