JESUITS and the PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE – Pt 1: LACUNZA, IRVING, DARBY, MACDONALD

After being in the ministry for a while I came to know that there is information online that states that the Jesuits made up the pre-tribulation rapture. For that very reason some don't believe in a pre-trib rapture. To be clear what that means is that Christ will come and receive His bride before the tribulation. In fact, it is the very thing that starts the tribulation. I did some deep research on this because I wanted to know what part the Jesuits played in all of this. I never want to believe a lie, I don't want to be deceived, nor do I want to deceive the flock that Jesus has entrusted to me. I have already taught on the pre-trib rapture and I encourage you to watch that teaching. The link is in my notes and in the info. box on Youtube and Bitchute.

Some people upon waking up to the truth of what has been going on in this world, begin to believe that everything we have been told, or taught or believed is a lie. It is dangerous to be in a state like that. The luciferians mix truth with lies.

The Jesuits said they would destroy the church through love. That seems to be working pretty well. People get their backs up if you call out their sin. They say you are not being loving if you stand against sin. The Jesuits teach only love, hope and grace but nothing on obedience or that God is a Judge as well. Just because a Jesuit teaches on love, will I then believe love is a lie too? No, I won't. The Bible tells us God is love. We must be careful when we know Jesuits have dabbled in something, and examine it closely. We must test the spirits, see what spirit is speaking, the Holy Spirit or another. We must check the teachings against God's Word.

It is worth mentioning that down through time theologians, those that claim to be experts on God's Word, have held certain beliefs and at times they have retracted them and changed their minds. You can look at Bible commentaries and see that they are not always in agreement. There are views that the book of Daniel has

already been fulfilled and so has the book of Revelation. There are those that believe we are already living in the millennial reign and on and on it goes.

As you grow and mature you understand God's Word better. The Holy Spirit, Who is our Teacher also corrects us. And you will learn through this teaching series that there are infiltrators of the church who have taught lies and deception on purpose to mess you up in your walk with God and what you believe.

Because there is so much controversy about the pretribulation rapture, I have looked at it as if it were a false teaching and yet I could not walk away from it. I tried to look at the Scriptures that speak of it and see if there was a different meaning or message but I could not see one. I put the pre-tribulation rapture to the test and it still stands.

As a Christian we all agree that the dead in Christ are going to be raised at some point. They will be raised first. And we believe when that happens that those who are still alive will be raised next and at that time we will all be together with the Lord.

In Biblical times many believed only in a general resurrection. The Saducees did not believe in a resurrection at all. It seems that what most people argue against with the pretribulation rapture is the timing of it, the secrecy of it and the speed of the whole event. It happens in the twinkling of an eye. The opponents of the pretrib rapture seem to believe in a post-tribulation rapture. They believe we must go through the tribulation. Some of them believe in a mid-trib rapture. Either way, they believe we must go through part or all of the tribulation.

1 Thess.5:9-10 - For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.

Salvation here means deliverance from this world. Saving us out of this world.

New Living Translation

Christ died for us so that, whether we are dead or alive when He returns, we can live with Him forever.

The rapture of the church was heavily taught by Paul. However, Jesus also spoke of it in these next passages:

Matt.24:37-44 – But as the days of Noe (Noah) were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up. Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

John 14:1-3 – Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions (dwelling places): if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

You tie what was said in Matt.24 about one taken and one left, over to John where Jesus says He is going away to prepare a place for us. If we are only raised at His Second Coming, where He then begins His Millennial Reign on this earth, what about the place He prepared for us? Are we to believe we are supposed to then wait 1000 more years to get to go and be with Him there? No, that's not right. And there are passages of Scripture that tell us plainly we will be with Him at His Second Coming:

Rev.17:14 - These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him *are* called, and chosen, and faithful.

Since we can clearly see that we are with Him for this battle, then we know that we must have gone to be with Him prior to this event. You have to study

Scripture and put it all together to understand why you believe what someone says or why you don't.

The biggest thing I hear as an argument against the pre-trib rapture is about terrible things that have happened on this earth. Like huge mass murdering of thousands and even millions of people. They will say, well Jesus did not come back. God does not stop every bad thing from happening. If He did that we'd be robots serving Him without any free will. He gives us free will. That means there are people who choose to do their will and that means to do evil and wicked things. God does love and protect us but He never said we would not face trials and tribulations. He has a set time when He will send Jesus back for the church. And some of us may die cruelly before that time just like the early apostles did, and many early Christians did. People have died for their faith all through time.

Jesus told us to watch and pray and to be ready because no one knows the day or the hour when He will return for us. No one knows except for the Father. We don't know if we will even live to the rapture, many have already died and gone on before us. Live your life in such a way that if He came for you today, you'd be ready to be judged by Him and you would truly be found to be one of His.

Let's talk about the word rapture.

Let us remember that the rapture comes straight out of Scripture. In the early latin Bible the word used was rapiemur and that is where the word rapture comes from. A seizure, kidnapping, carrying off. We are caught up or taken away from, it is to catch up or to take away and the idea is suddenly or immediately with force. Get that picture in your head. This world is already so dark and wicked and Jesus is going to snatch us up so fast that satan's head is going to spin. Everyone will be caught off guard by it. Jesus will return with the element of surprise. Like a surprise attack against His enemies and it will be because the world is really going to go into chaos at that point when He removes His bride.

1 Thess.4:13-18 - But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

In the teaching on the rapture, I shared my personal testimony of seeking out the truth on that subject. I had started thinking maybe the rapture is after the tribulation or even in the middle as my pastor at the time did not teach or speak on the rapture. In fact, I did not even know what he believed or his stance on it

until I asked him point blank. None of my pastors over the years had taught on it. So I set out to study the subject and all the while I prayed and sought God to show me the truth and to give me peace on the subject. He certainly did.

Early on in this ministry God began to show me the truth of this world and of so many things that were going on. He called me to expose those things. I heard that the Jesuits were the ones who put the teachings out there about a pretribulation rapture. That bothered me because I had already learned that they are the militant arm of the Vatican or the Roman Catholic Church. And that one of their goals is to tear down God's church from the inside. They are standing in the pulpits. They are the same as witches, they are of a secret society and order that is against God and all Christians. So I thought, how did they start this teaching when it is in our Bibles? So this teaching is going to reveal what they did.


Let's look at some of the characters involved in this idea that the Jesuits are behind the pre-trib rapture.





In my research I learned that in the 1790's he completed a book he had written entitled "The Coming of the Messiah in Glory and Majesty." John Bray is someone who said that he floated the idea of a pre-trib rapture in this book. Just for the record

John Bray was a freemason. You can find Lacunza's book online for free as a pdf. I searched and searched his book and could not find where he taught a pre-trib rapture at all.

Also, I'm not promoting his book, he is a Jesuit, so even if he did not falsely teach about the pre-tribulation rapture, he certainly could have written other things that were not accurate. That is what happens when you stray away from Scripture, you get into man's opinions and you get into things that were written purposely to deceive you. Stick with God's Word.

And yet another person involved in the spreading of the pre-tribulation rapture teaching is John Nelson Darby.




The last one is Margaret MacDonald who supposedly had a vision from God and it supported the pre-trib rapture position.
