## HOUSE CHURCH MEETINGS IN THE VILLAGES

House church meetings were held every month to assess the spiritual growth of the community and ensure that the Word of God was reaching every household. These gatherings provided a platform to discuss not only the spiritual well-being of the villagers but also their daily struggles

Awareness sessions on essential topics like water catchment, polyhouses, and sanitation were conducted, ensuring that the most in-need members of the community received support.

We created visual aids and

charts to educate villagers on maintaining hygiene and keeping their surroundings clean, reinforcing both physical and spiritual well-being. The primary goal of these house church meetings is to strengthen women as spiritual leaders in their families and communities while empowering them to take charge of their households. This initiative, supported by Three Heart Ministry, has created a profound impact on the villages, transforming lives not just economically and socially, but most importantly, spiritually. Through these efforts, the gospel has been spread, and God's presence has been deeply felt among the people, marking the success of this mission at the grassroots level.

### A New Hope for Sobani Devi

Sobani Devi, a 39-year-old woman from Jawarna Village, faced great hardship after her husband passed away from a heart attack in 2017. Left alone to care for her three young children and her elderly mother-in-law, she struggled to provide for her family. Though she had a few cows and sold milk in the village, the income was too little to meet their needs. There were days when she worried about how to feed her children and pay for their school fees, books, and uniforms. Life was full of uncertainty, and she often felt hopeless. In her time of need, Sobani turned to a Self-Help Group (SHG) for guidance. The SHG shared her struggles with Three Heart Ministry, a Christian organization dedicated to serving the needy. With love and care, the ministry provided her with the support she needed. They helped her build a polyhouse to grow vegetables and trained her in farming techniques. Through this training, she learned how to care for her crops, conserve water, and use organic methods. Most importantly, she found a group of supportive women who shared her burdens and prayed with her. Through faith and hard work,

Sobani's life began to change. With the vegetables she grew, she started selling fresh produce in the local market. This gave her a steady income, allowing her to take care of her family's needs. Now, she can pay for her children's education and manage household expenses without fear. She no longer feels alone she has a community of women who encourage and support her. Her heart is filled with gratitude to God, who provided for her through the kindness of others. Sobani's journey has made her stronger and more confident. She now inspires other women in her village, sharing the same love and hope she received. Her dream is to expand her vegetable farming and help more women through the SHG. She prays that God will use her life as a testimony of His faithfulness and love. The Three Heart Ministry project did more than just provide financial help; it restored hope and dignity to Sobani's family. Today, she walks in faith, knowing that God has a plan for her and her children. Her story is a reminder that when we trust in the Lord and help one another, miracles can happen.



### **Rising Strong: A Journey of Faith and Blessings**

Our dairy farm is running with eleven widows and seven women abandoned by their husbands faced great hardship. Left alone to care for their children, they struggled to find hope. But God



had a plan for them. Though society had overlooked them, He never did. Through His grace, an opportunity came learning the skills of dairy farming. With hearts full of faith, they eagerly attended training sessions, gaining knowledge on how to care for cows and produce milk. They trusted that the Lord would bless the work of their hands. As their farms grew, so did their confidence. No longer bound by fear and uncertainty, they could provide for their families. Every drop of milk was a reminder of God's provision. Their children had food, clothes, and an education, and they lived with dignity once more. But the blessings did not stop with them. Their story became a testimony

of faith and perseverance. Others in the village saw their transformation and were inspired. The women became a light to their community, proving that through faith and hard work, all things are possible with God. What started as a small dairy project became a story of hope, resilience, and God's unfailing love. These women, once forgotten, now stood strong, shining as living testimonies of His goodness. Through their journey, they reminded everyone that with faith, unity, and God's grace, new beginnings are always possible.





## Hostel Program

Three Heart Ministry continues to run a hostel program in our village, providing a safe and loving home for 22 children. Some of these children have lost both parents, while others come from single-parent families. One of the children in our care was abandoned by his family due to his disability. His parents believed that his physical condition was a curse, so they left him. But we know that every child is a precious gift from God, wonderfully made in His image (Psalm 139:14). We have welcomed him with love, just as Christ welcomes us, and we pray that he grows up knowing how deeply he is loved by God. Our dedicated team of four staff members looks after the children with love and care, ensuring their physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being. Every Sunday, Pastor Dalbeer Singh leads Bible teachings, helping the children grow in their knowledge of God's Word. We believe that education is important, but even more important is building a strong foundation in Christ. Through daily prayers, worship, and scripture lessons, we guide these children to walk in faith, knowing that Jesus loves them and has a purpose for their lives. At Three Heart Ministry, we see this work as part of God's greater mission. We are not just providing shelter and education we are planting seeds for His Kingdom. Our goal is to raise children who will grow in faith, love, and kindness, carrying God's light wherever they go. We thank God for His faithfulness in sustaining this ministry.
